



IMPORTANT INFORMATION ABOUT YOUR DRINKING WATER

Reporting Requirement Not Met for Consolidated PWSD #1

Our system failed to demonstrate to the State that it delivered the appropriate information on the annual notifications to consumers with status unknown service lines as required by July 1, **2024**. Although the failure to comply with the reporting requirement **does not create a risk to public health**, we are required to inform you of this violation and provide additional information including what we did to correct the situation.

It is important for consumers to know if the water they are receiving has been delivered through a lead, galvanized requiring replacement (GRR), or lead status unknown service line so they can make decisions on whether and what actions to take to reduce their exposure to lead in drinking water.

What should I do?

There is nothing you need to do at this time. You do not need to boil your water or take other actions. Remember, boiling water does not remove lead from water.
